

New Tour Master Cruiser II bag collection breaks company's best-seller sales record

Tour Master's new Cruiser II bag collection consists of eight sissybar bag styles and sizes, four saddlebag variations, and six different tool bags. It is constructed of a synthetic material that looks and feels like heavy-grained leather, but is easier to clean and maintain, resisting such problems as stains, mildew, and rust. The bags also feature second-generation upgrade features, including reinforced construction for better shape retention even when the bags are empty, exclusive "ultra soft" Neoprene pads to protect the bike's finish, improved universal mounting

systems, and a new quick-release buckle system hidden behind traditional chrome buckles and straps so the bags open and close quicker and easier.

Coming in eight sizes, the sissybar bags have box-style lids designed for optimum water and dust protection. The new universal mounting system is secure, adjustable, holds the bag in place without sagging and fits all types of backrests. A newly designed rain/dust cover is included at no extra cost, as are new, padded backpack straps for easier off-bike carrying. The removable barrel bag comes with a

shoulder strap for carrying separately.

The tool bags are available in three models, each in two styles, including a sissybar tool bag with large, wrap-around closure flap with two over-the-top straps and two inner side straps that can be mounted on the lower front frame of some bikes as a tool bag or to a backrest as a sissybar bag.

Suggested retail prices range from \$99.99 to \$259.99 for the sissybar bags, \$119.99 to \$199.99 for the saddlebags, and \$34.99 to \$39.99 for tool bags.
